## **Alumni Award Nomination Information**

Alumni Awards are bestowed to those individuals who best exemplify the Grinnell spirit by their service to the College, their professional accomplishment, and/or their service to their community.

## The requirements for a nomination are:

- Two or more letters of support (one can come from the nominator).
- Supporting materials (newspaper clippings, newsletters, citations, etc.), if available. Please provide materials in Microsoft Word or PDF formats.
- A completed, detailed nomination form.
- Nominees are only considered for the Alumni Award when they are celebrating a reunion.

No more than 15 alumni are awarded each year. Of these 15, two may be awarded as Pioneer Awards, specific to young alumni who are 10 years or less out from graduation.

Current trustees and current Alumni Council members are not eligible for an Alumni Award. Nominations for alumni from non-reunion classes will be accepted but held until the appropriate Reunion year. Alumni who have received a Pioneer Award in the past are not eligible for an Alumni Award.
