As the co-host of a weekly streaming show for the Lincoln Project, she's on a mission to save democracy with comedy.



Sarah Aswell '03 is a writer and comedian living in Missoula, Montana. Currently the Special Projects Editor at Scary Mommy, her writing has appeared in *The New Yorker, McSweeney's, National Lampoon, MAD Magazine, Reductress, Forbes*, and more. She's also written for brands like Nike, Facebook, and Kitchenaid. An alum of the Big Sky Comedy Festival and HBO's Women in Comedy Festival, she was recently named one of the best unknown comedians in *America* by Thrillist, which is one of those insults that sounds like a compliment.



Alvin Irby'07 is a former kindergarten teacher turned award-winning social entrepreneur, international speaker, comedian, and author. As Founder of Barbershop Books, he was awarded the National Book Foundation's Innovations in Reading Prize. Irby's keynotes and professional development workshops help school districts, library systems, and education organizations create relevant and engaging learning experiences for all students.
