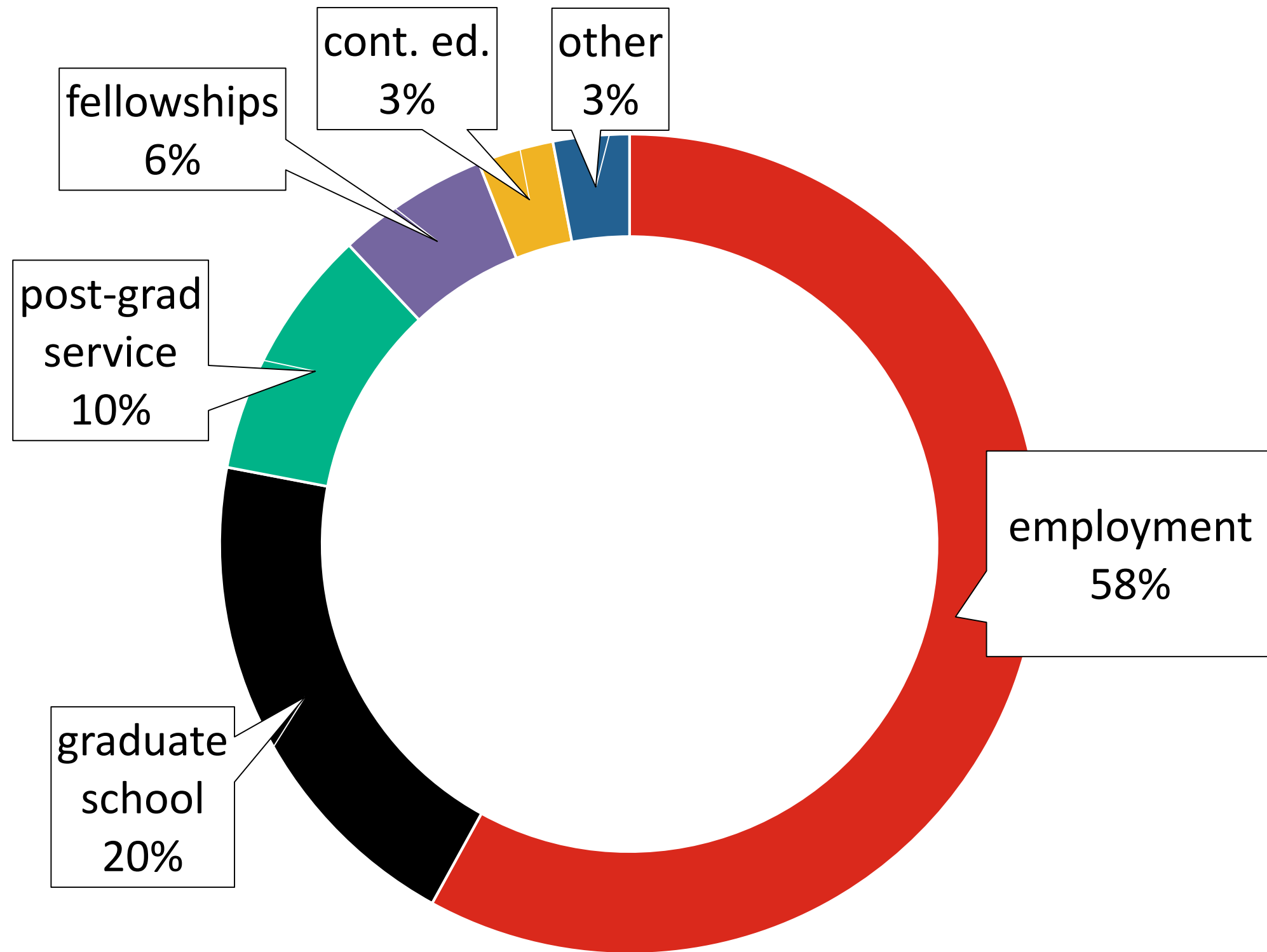

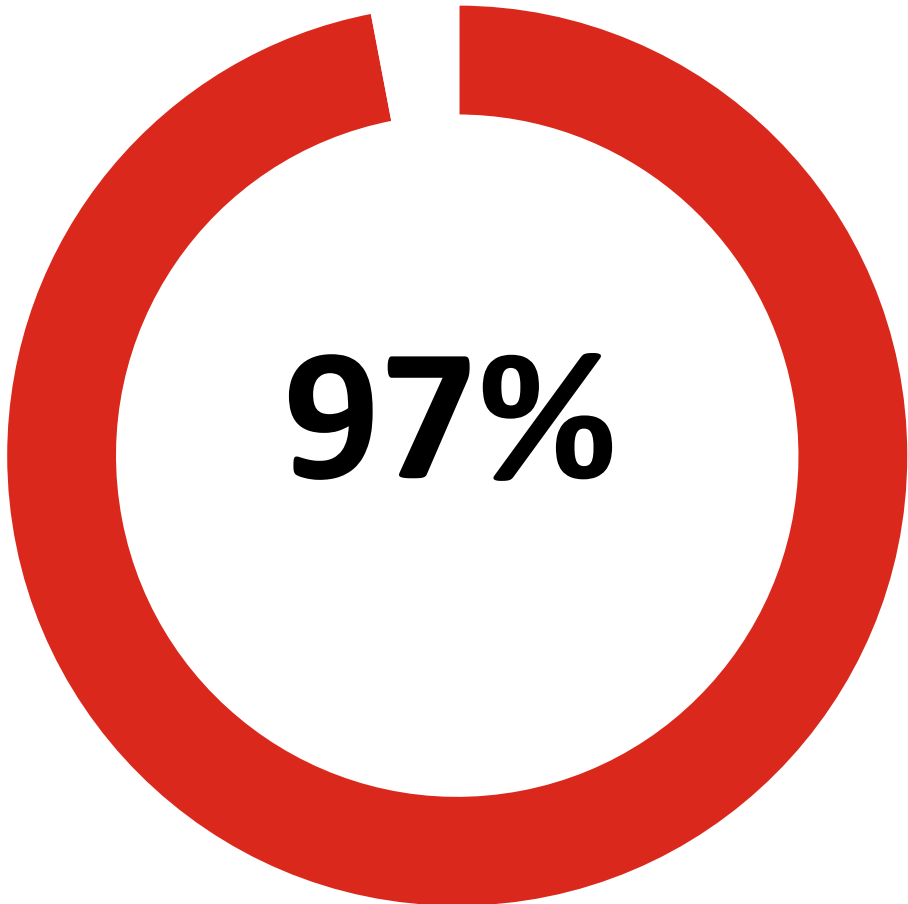

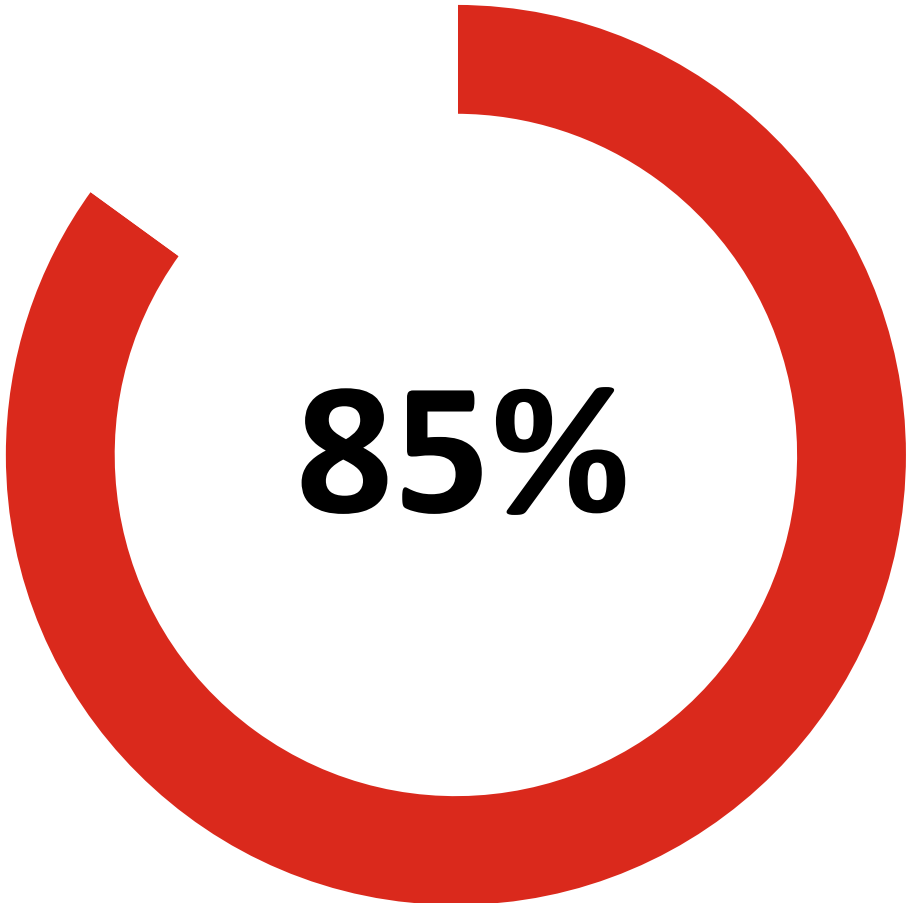

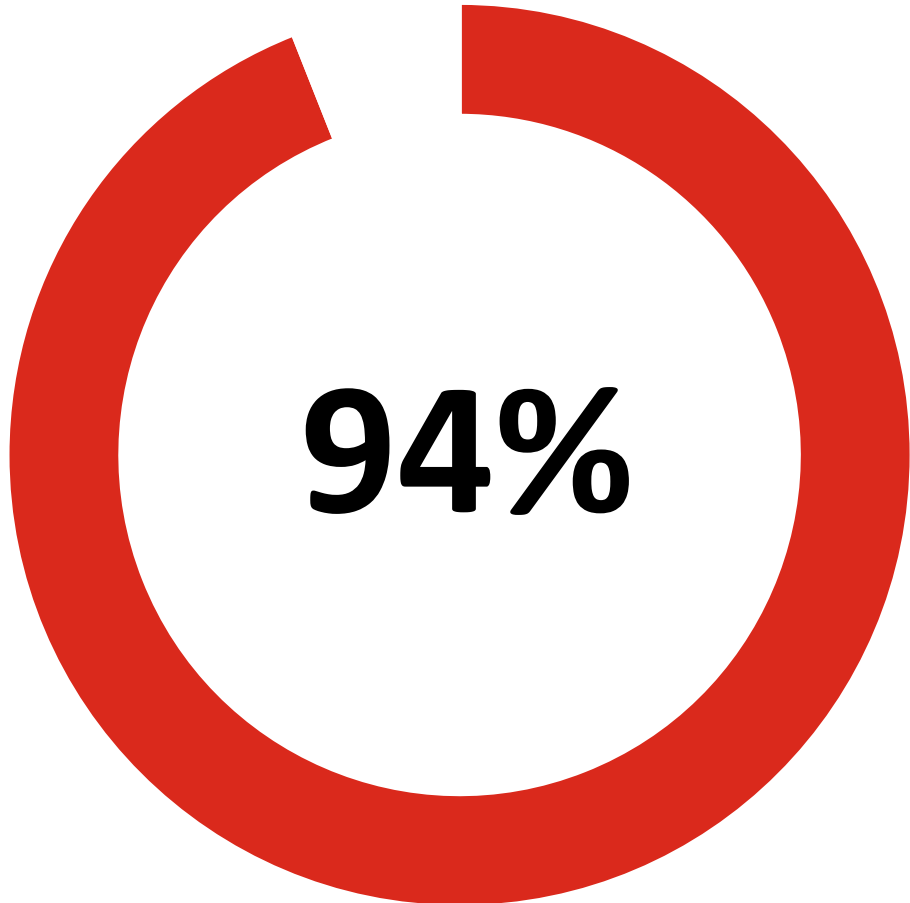
Percent of graduates who are employed or pursuing further education
